

Indigenous Student Trustee

Trustees recommended for approval the creation of an Indigenous Student Trustee position on the Grand Erie District School Board, effective August 1, 2018. This means, that any self-identified Indigenous secondary school student will be eligible for the new Student Trustee positon. Elections, which will take place



this spring, will follow the same process currently used to select other Grand Erie Student Trustees. This report supports Grand Erie's Multi-Year Plan and Success for Every Student through both the Achievement and Equity indicators. It supports Achievement through the following statement: "We will set high expectations for our students and staff" and Equity through the goal of "increasing the sense of belonging among students." Draft Proposed School Year Calendar 2018-19

Trustees recommended for approval the Draft Proposed School Year Calendar for 2018-19. The draft calendar was prepared by the Grand Erie School Year Calendar Committee and was developed in collaboration with the Brant Haldimand Norfolk Catholic School Board.
