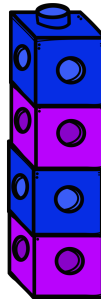

In math we have been working on:

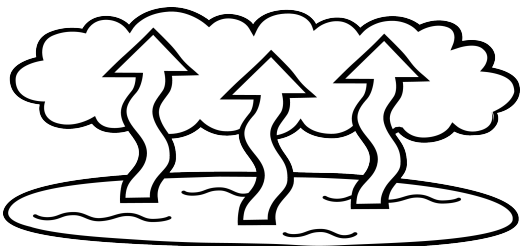
- Proper Number formation

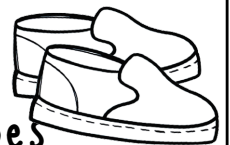

Headphones



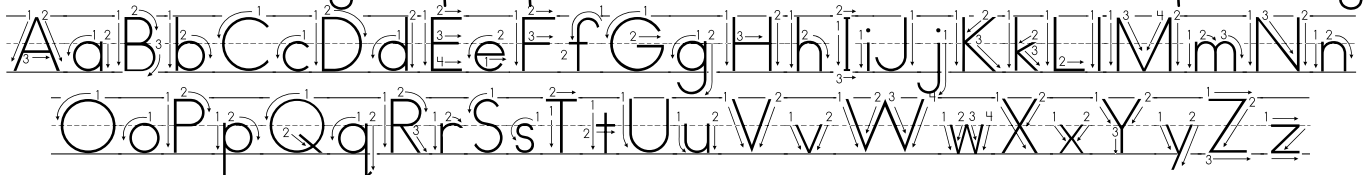
If you have not already done so, please send in a labelled pair of headphones for students to use in the computer lab and keep at school.

As we are writing words we are learning to use proper case (no capitals in the middle of words) and capitalizing proper words.

We are ending our sentences with correct punctuation.

Reading

As part of our reading program we are working on our mastery of common words. These words are also part of our spelling program. Every Monday we have 10 new words to learn to read and spell. On Friday we “test” these words. Your child is bringing home a TWAS (this week at school) red duo tang.
