December 2017 kindergarten news



Well, it's officially December and the weather has been beautiful but we are bound to get some colder temperatures soon enough. Language/ Math:

Our guided reading groups are going very well and help guide the best level of book to send home in your child's reading folders. You may write a different title on each line and when the page is full, your child will put a sticker on the front of their folder. The books sent are not the only books you can record. You can record any books read by or with your child and they can be written as many times as are read. Please encourage your child to point to each word and use the pictures as clues. This helps catch mistakes and helps them notice the spaces between

words to identify them as separate words in a sentence.

Don't forget to return folders each Monday to exchange new books!

This month we have a variety of language and numeracy activities planned that will revolve around Gingerbread!

There are some great Gingerbread stories to explore!



<u>KLLIC</u>: Our current KLLIC cycle story is "We're Going On a Bear Hunt". When we read it, there is a lot of repetition so students join in and are working on their own booklet to help them retell the story. Ask your child what sounds go with each part of the story. The letter sound associated with this cycle is /g/ and it also has a focus on syllables and counting beats. We have

been clapping our names, animal names and recognizing that words can be broken into "chunks". Ask your child to clap their name or yours. Remember SK students will bring home a newsletter and "shortened" version of the story to help support this at home. These are for you to keep.
