The grade threes have been busy working hard throughout the month of January. We have been improving our stamina in reading, writing and math. As we move into Term 2 of Grade 3, it is important that we continue to work hard in order to prepare for EQAO testing at the end of May.

Reading Focus

I am so happy to see that students are reading at home. Whether your child is bringing books home in their Home Reading folder or using Raz-kids.com, it is essential they read books at their reading level in order to improve fluency and comprehension. When reading with your child, you could ask questions such as: What do you think this text will be about? What did you notice about this story? What do you think the character is feeling? Why? Congratulations to several students this month that read another twenty books at home! These students were rewarded with a brand new book to keep.

Writing Focus

Recently, we wrote a thank you letter together to Mrs. Heeg after taking part in the milk presentation. She gave a lot of information in a fun and exciting way. If you haven't yet, ask your child to tell you a bit about the presentation. Letter writing will be a part of our writing focus.

Story writing is also a part of our writing focus. We have learned to include the five W's: who (characters), where (setting), when (time), what (problem and events), why (solution) to write more complete stories.

Math Focus

We are currently wrapping up a Geometry unit and will be moving on to Data Management and Probability.

Students have been using Prodigy.com as part of our math program at school. I have questions set up specifically that address the unit we are currently working on. Students are welcome and encouraged to use Prodigy.com at home as well.

General information
