Hopefully you are all enjoying the home reading program: Raz-kids.com Please take full advantage of this program over the March Break.

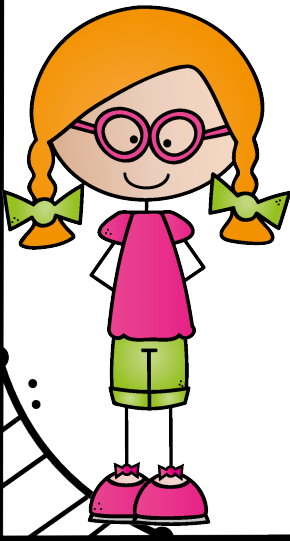
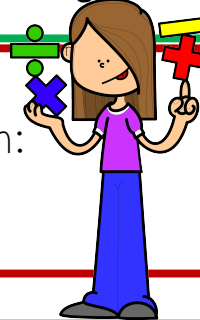
This month there is a focus on answering questions with support from text.
