Weather has been changing but the wind is still cool, please continue to check the temperatures outside before sending your child to school unprepared!

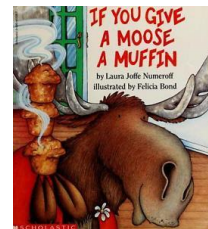
The School activities will appear on the calendar found on the School Website:

KLLIC: We are still working on "If You Give a Moose a Muffin" and learning to use "Moose Talk" to stretch out our words which helps us print the sounds we hear and lends to beginning writers! Stretch out words and have your child try identifying what sound they hear in conversation.
