



- In Language, we are learning about Point of View. Please talk to your child about their P.O.V., as well as someone else's P.O.V. Have them remember that other points of view are just as important to consider as their own.
- Reading and writing are always VERY important in our classroom. Please keep reading with your child at home. Classroom books will not be sent home after June 15th, so please visit the public library to get books so you can continue reading every day. Please encourage your child to read daily, and ask them questions about the characters, setting, problem and solution.
- We will be starting a media literacy unit soon. We will be viewing different types of media and then making our own advertisements. Please send in an empty cereal box to class by June 7th. We always welcome extras if you have them. Thank you!
- This year in social studies, our class has learned about families – how they are all different and unique. Soon, I will send home family tree leaves. Please fill them out and return by June 15th. **Please only fill out the names and their relationship to the child. We will be colouring them and making a family tree at school.** If you need more, please send me a message.
- In math, we will be learning about money – nickels, dimes, quarters, loonies and toonies. Please practice these at home. Grade ones are to make money amounts to 20 cents and grade twos to 1 dollar.
- Now that the hot weather is here, please make sure your child has sunscreen on BEFORE they come to school every day. Students also need a hat and a refillable bottle of water, because we will be outside a lot during the month of June.
- Library books need to be returned by June 11th. If your book is not returned, a note will come home with the price of the book. The book or the money will need to be at school by the end of this school year, or your child will not be able to take books out next school year.
