Math Calendars and Grids

Starting this month your child will be bringing home a monthly math calendar. This calendar has a math question for each day of the month. Once the calendar has been completed your child will receive a completion mark and a PRIZE! The questions can be done directly on the page or on lined paper and placed in the duotang. The Math Grids are to strengthen your child's math facts knowledge. They should be completed weekly as homework as they will be tested on Fridays. The math grids start at a grade 1 level and go up to grade 8. Each level is timed and may require more weeks of practice in order to move up. Further instructions for each weeks math grids can be found within the orange duotang in your child's agenda bag.

What we are learning this month:

Reading: We will soon be finishing the new "Diary of a Wimpy kid" and moving on the novel "Strays Like Us". Keep up the great work with earning reading coupons! Parents please don't forget to sign the monthly calendar on the days that your child reads to help them earn all the coupons!

Writing: We are currently working on writing our own versions of "Diary of a Wimpy kid" and will be focusing on making connections to texts this month.
