We did great with our comics! We're going to learn about Letter Writing Styles and then work our way into Story Writing by the end of the month! What can you do at home? Practice word families and rhymes. They help with spelling soooooo much. Try it on a Springtime walk. $\qquad$ For example: I know how to spell cake. Do you know how to spell make? Jake? Rake? Take? Then try another......Do you know how to spell at? If you know how to spell at, you can spell cat, that, mat, etc.
