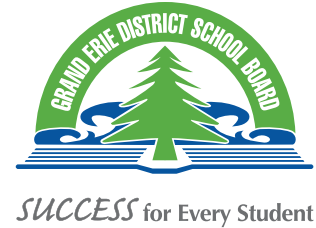

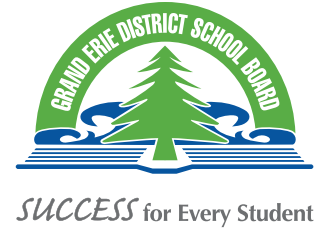


Literacy Calendar

Grand Erie values languages and home cultures. We invite all our families and students to complete some of these activities in English, French, or their own first/home language.

Date	Activity
Monday, May 11	Rhyme time! What words can you think of that rhyme with frog?
Tuesday, May 12	Look at pictures or drawings in books or other material such as magazines. Ask your child to tell you how they think the character is feeling and ask how they know. They might say “she looks happy because she is smiling.”
Wednesday, May 13	Have your child make their own book about feelings and draw different facial expressions.
Thursday, May 14	The word “the” shows up a lot. Have your child look through books or other materials to see how many times they can find this word. Have them put a finger on either side of the word. Write this short sentence for them on a piece of paper and have them cut out the word “the”: The cat is black.
Friday, May 15	Create a pattern book with your child using the word “the” with short sentences on each page. For example, on the first page write “The truck is big” and on the next page write “The tree is big”. Let your child decide what other things you can include. Get them to draw or cut out the pictures to match the sentences. They can use the picture to help them reread the book you have created together.

Numeracy Calendar

Date	Activity
Monday, May 11	Roll a die or use a deck of cards and count on to 10 from the number that was rolled/picked. Repeat this with different numbers.
Tuesday, May 12	When doing laundry, sort objects by similarities and differences. Have your child help sort the clothes into whites, darks, and colors before washing them. Have your child match the socks. Have them sort their clothes. Have your child tell you how they sorted.
Wednesday, May 13	Read a book together. While reading talk about the different shapes in the pictures. Ask your child: What shapes do you see? How do you know? Can you find a circle, a square, a rectangle, a triangle?
Thursday, May 14	Talk about your day. Use vocabulary for what happens first, second, and third to show that things happen in order. What happens in the morning? What do we do before bedtime?
Friday, May 15	Play guess my number. Pick a number between 0-10. Have your child guess your number. Tell them if their guess was too high or too low, to help them get closer to the correct number. Have your child pick a number and have you guess their number.
