Grand Opening of Lakewood Child Care Centre (Lakewood Elementary School), 713 St George St, Port Dover, Ontario

Today's Family Early Learning and Child Care in partnership with the Grand Erie District School Board invite you to the Grand Opening of Lakewood Child Care Centre. We are pleased to welcome The Honourable Liz Sandals, Minister of Education, to commemorate the official opening celebration with us. The partnership between the child care provider and the board came as an opportunity from a Pupil Accommodation Review that repurposed Port Dover Composite School into Lakewood Elementary School. With additional space in the elementary school, a capital allocation of \$540,000 was provided by the Ministry of Education Child Care Retrofit Program to welcome Today's Family into the Grand Erie school. The retrofit project included a renovation of existing shop classrooms to convert into the daycare facility, the conversion of existing food prep space to accommodate both the parent food program as well as dedicated kitchen for daycare food service, and an updated an AODA barrier-free unisex washroom. Families from the community were welcomed into the centre as of October 5, 2015.
