Literacy Calendar

Grand Erie values languages and home cultures. We invite all our families and students to complete some of these activities in English, French, or their own first/home language.

Date	Activity
Monday, April 20	Read a book together and discuss what happens in the story. Ask your child which part they liked and then act out that part together.
Tuesday, April 21	Create a menu together. Have your child sound out words with you and draw pictures for each item.
Wednesday, April 22	Ask your child to pick a letter. Come up with a list of words that start with that letter. Encourage your child to draw pictures to go with the words.
Thursday, April 23	Read a book together and ask your child to draw a picture of his/her favourite character.
Friday, April 24	Look out the window and ask your child questions about what they see.

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Numeracy Calendar

Date	Activity
Monday, April 20	Ask your child to find and draw three things around the house that are taller than they are. Ask them to find and draw 3 things that are shorter than they are.
Tuesday, April 21	Go on a number hunt around your home. Talk with your child about the numbers they find and what they mean.
Wednesday, April 22	Play a board game like snakes and ladders.
Thursday, April 23	Have your child use a household item like a spoon to measure. Measure the length of a favourite stuffed toy.
Friday, April 24	Have your child line up 10 toys. Ask them to point to which one is first, then which one is second, third etc.
