What is EQAO? The Education Quality and Accountability Office (EQAO) is an evidence-based, research-informed organization that operates as an arm's length government agency. It contributes to the quality and accountability of Ontario's publicly funded education system for K-12. The data provided by EQAO is used to inform student, school, and board improvement.

#### Assessments Conducted by EQAO:

- 1) Primary (Gr. 3) and Junior (Gr. 6) Assessment of Reading, Writing and Mathematics
- 2) Grade 9 Assessment of Mathematics Worth 10% of student's final grade in their grade 9 math (MTH1W) course.
- 3) Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT) Successful completion of the literacy test is one of the requirements to earn an Ontario Secondary School Diploma


