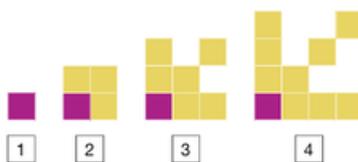


Grade 3 EQAO Sample Question for Families

Question

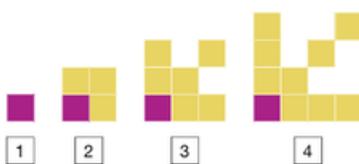
How many tiles in total would be in the 6th position of this growing pattern?

Helpful Tips:

- **Support students in understanding what the pattern represents.** Term number is the step (1, 2, 3...) and the term value is how many tiles.
- **Use household materials to construct this and other patterns** (e.g., coins, buttons, beans, small squares cut from paper).
- **Connect questions to the representation, ask:** What stays the same? What gets added each time? This supports students in seeing the structure of the pattern and not simply counting.
- **Translate the pattern to a table** (e.g., Term Number and Number of Tiles).
