## Play Guess My Word

## Fireworks in a Jar

Fill a clear glass jar  $\frac{3}{4}$  full with water. Add 3 to 4 tablespoons of oil on the top of the water to form an oil layer. Add several drops of food colouring in various colours on the top of the oil layer in the jar. Watch what happens next!



Stick a pencil in a paper plate and place in the sun.

Then, use marker to trace the shadow once every hour and label the line with the time. Do this all day, and you've made a sundial!

## Write Instructions

Write the instructions for making one of your favourite snacks. Then you can follow the instructions and have a yummy treat!

## Read a Story

Read a book together. After reading, take turns asking and answering questions about what happened or what you learned from the book.

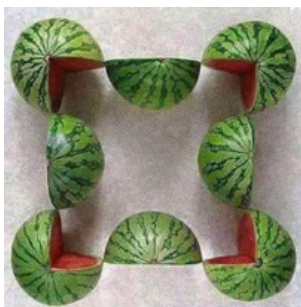


## Angle Hunt

Identify angles outside and determine if they are greater than or less than  $90^\circ$  (an L shape). Tip: the corner of a book or piece of paper measures  $90^\circ$ .

## Play Word Catch

To play this game you need to start a new word with the letter or sound at the end of the last player's word. If you say "trip" the next player must come up with a word that starts with P.



Create a number line using chalk and rocks. Call out an equation (such as  $9 + 5$  or  $19 - 5$ ) and have your child place a rock on the answer.
