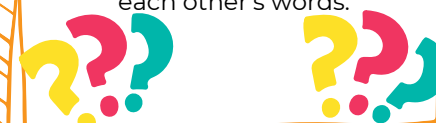
Which Shape is Stronger?

Which shape is the strongest to hold a collection of books when placed on top? Try it out!

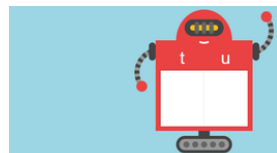


Guess My Word

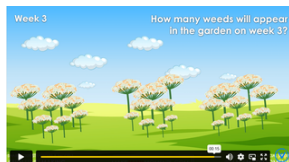

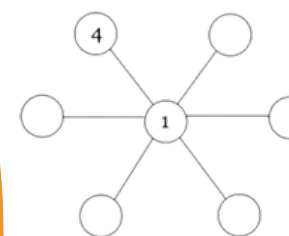
Play 21 Questions

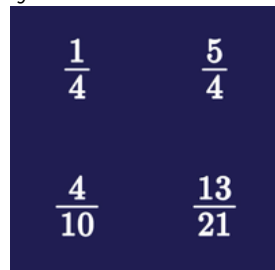
The Longest Sentence
