

School clinic immunizations

This **[fall/spring]**, Grand Erie Public Health will be visiting all elementary schools this to offer in-school vaccinations clinics for Grade 7 and 8 students. Students can receive the following publicly funded vaccines at these clinics:

- Hepatitis B (2 doses)
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV) (2 doses)
- Meningococcal (Men C-ACYW-135) (1 dose - required for school attendance under Immunization of School Pupils Act unless exempt).

The clinics are intended for students who have not yet received their first dose or are due for their second.

These vaccines are safe, effective, and strongly recommended as part of Ontario's Routine Immunization Schedule. Vaccines help protect against serious illnesses (e.g., HPV can prevent certain types of cancers) and can prevent diseases that can lead to hospitalization and significant health complications.

Keeping up to date with routine immunizations helps protect not only your child but the wider community, especially those who are more vulnerable.
