OSAP (Ontario Student Assistance Program)	Offer student loans and grants for post-secondary programs	• www.osap.gov.on.ca
Financial Institutions (Banks)	Offer <i>personal loans</i> with terms similar to OSAP	Visit your <i>personal bank</i>
Colleges and Universities	Entrance Scholarships; different post-secondary schools offer all sorts of financial awards, bursaries, grants, etc. based on your grade 12 grades	Check the <i>Financial Aid page</i> of the specific schools you are considering applying to Check <i>application deadlines</i> carefully for all potential awards
Simcoe Composite School Commencement Awards	Some commencement awards are accompanied with financial benefits	Students may apply for awards in <i>Spring</i> (info will be shared and posted in advance)
Simcoe/ Norfolk Community Scholarships	Various community members and organizations offer financial awards for students going into specific careers or subject-specific programs	Check the <i>Scholarship Board</i> in <i>Guidance</i> , listen for <i>announcements</i> , watch Sabre TV & school <i>social media</i> sites for new posts
