- Full Credit courses run for the entire four-week duration
- Upgrade courses run for 2 weeks, beginning July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021
- Math Transfer courses run for 2 weeks and can start on July 6<sup>th</sup> OR July 19<sup>th</sup>
- First semester will run July 6-16, while second semester will run July 19-30.
- CREDIT RECOVERY COURSES START JULY 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021 AND END JULY 16<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
  - Students MUST contact their guidance counsellor to be registered in this program.
- ALL E-LEARNING COURSES WILL OPEN TO STUDENTS ON JUNE 29 THROUGH JULY.
