This is Principal Regan Vankerrebroeck. I'm reaching out today with an important message.

The Haldimand-Norfolk Health Unit has informed us that an individual in our school community has a confirmed case of COVID-19. Understandably, for privacy reasons, the identity of this individual will not be disclosed. This individual has been directed by the health unit to <u>self-isolate</u>, along with any family members who reside in the same household.

At this time, the Haldimand-Norfolk Health Unit has not identified any close contacts at our school to this COVID-19 case. If we receive additional information from the health unit that Dunnville Secondary students or staff are impacted, we will let you know as soon as possible.

Dunnville Secondary School remains open. Grand Erie custodians continue to complete their disinfecting of our school each night.

A friendly reminder that all Dunnville Secondary students and staff are required to monitor their health daily and pass the <u>COVID-19 School and Child Care Screening Tool</u> before entering our building. If students or staff develop symptoms consistent with COVID-19, they are required to contact their primary health care provider. Anyone concerned that they may have developed or been exposed to COVID-19 is encouraged to get tested.
