School Messenger - COVID-19

Good Afternoon Bloomsburg Public School Families,

This is Principal Samantha Nicholson. I'm reaching out with an important message.

Late this morning, the Haldimand-Norfolk Health Unit confirmed a case of COVID-19 in our school community. Understandably, for privacy reasons, the identity of this individual will not be disclosed. This individual has been directed by the health unit to self-isolate, along with any family members who reside in the same household.

Upon receiving this news, we immediately contacted the students and staff initially identified by the Haldimand-Norfolk Health Unit as close contacts to this COVID-19 case. The Haldimand-Norfolk Health Unit will be in direct contact with these individuals as they work through their contact tracing. The health unit will provide further direction and next steps to these individuals.

If your family was not contacted, you have not been identified as a close contact at this time. If further Bloomsburg students or staff are impacted, the Haldimand-Norfolk Health Unit will let us know as soon as possible.

Bloomsburg Public School remains open. Grand Erie custodians continue to complete their disinfecting of our school each and every night. Moving forward, Bloomsburg staff will work with students and families to ensure learning continues for those who are required to self-isolate.

A friendly reminder that all Grand Erie students and staff are required to monitor their health daily. If symptoms consistent with COVID-19 develop, please contact your primary health care provider. Anyone concerned they may have developed or been exposed to COVID-19 is encouraged to get tested.
