#### **GUIDELINES FOR EATING AT SCHOOL DURING COVID-19**

While at school, rules must be followed during nutrition breaks to ensure a healthy and safe break for all students. Please discuss the following guidelines with your child/children.

- 1. Classes will eat lunch in their own classrooms.
- 2. Students will use the washroom and wash their hands before eating.
- 3. All students will be polite, courteous and respectful of adults, students and property.
- 4. Students are encouraged to bring enough food for 2 nutrition breaks.
- 5. Students will bring and use personal water bottles. Please do not send glass containers.
- 6. Water fountains will be closed, but bottle-filling stations will be available.
- 7. Sharing of food or beverages is not permitted.
- 8. Students will remain seated in their designated spots and may talk quietly.
- 9. When they are given a signal, they must pack up their lunch, clean up their area appropriately and sanitize their hands, before they exit under the supervision of the teacher on duty.
- 10. Students will wear their mask while they line up to exit the building.
