Vaccines are safe and continue to represent the most effective strategy to protect Ontarians from COVID-19. It is also important for the protection of our youngest children (0-4) years, who are not yet eligible for vaccine protection. ## Consent

**No student will be vaccinated without parental consent.** Parents will also be able to accompany their child at the clinic should they wish.

**It is important to note that participation in school-based clinics is voluntary.**

If you wish your child to receive a vaccination, please call the school at 519.442.4163. If you wish to accompany your child, please let us know when you call us.

The attached [consent form](#) along with a completed Medical History form should also be filled out and presented together to the BCHU personnel at the clinic. School staff will not be collecting these consent forms. BCHU on site staff may need to follow up with a parent by phone if any information is missing from the forms on the day of the clinic.
