Suspension, Revision or Repeal of any Bylaw, Policy, Procedure or Protocol

## 1. Temporary Suspension

Any of the Board's Bylaws, Policies or Procedures may be temporarily suspended by motion that receives an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Board members present. A motion for temporary suspension of a specific Bylaw, Policy or Procedure must specify the length of time.

2. Notice to Revise or Repeal By-Law or Policy Two weeks' notice must be given of any motion to revise any Bylaw or Policy of the Board.

## 3. Revisions to Conform to Local, Provincial, and Federal Laws

The Director of Education shall make revisions to conform to local, provincial, and federal laws and, when necessary, to Bylaws, Policies, Procedures and Protocols, and present such changes to the Board for confirmation.
