Purpose

- Advise and provide recommendations to Board of Trustees on attendance area changes in review area
- School closures cannot be considered under a Boundary Review process



Membership

- Superintendent of Education responsible for the identified school(s) (chair)
- Planning Supervisor
- Planning Officer
- Principal of the identified school(s)
- Up to two School Council Representatives of the identified schools
- Two Trustees
- Superintendent of Business



Responsibilities

- Review Objectives
- Public information and access
- Boundary options
- Community consultation and public meetings
- Report to Finance Committee



Meeting Procedures

- An initial meeting schedule will be established by Board staff; changes to meetings including adding or cancelling meeting dates may be made by the BRSAC.
- BRSAC meetings are not public meetings. Non-members may attend meetings provided they are invited by the BRSAC.
- Minutes will be taken at each meeting and approved at subsequent BRSAC meetings.
- BRSAC meeting minutes and presentation materials will be posted on the Board's website after minutes approval at subsequent BRSAC meeting.
- Public Meeting materials will be posted on the Board's website for public consumption prior to the public meeting. Public Meeting minutes will be posted on the Board's website after review and approval by the BRSAC, at the next BRSAC meeting.



GEDSB Boundary Review Reference Criteria:

Where possible, boundary options should take into consideration:

Grade Configuration

• JK-8, and 9-12 are preferred school organizations. However, other school organizations (such as 7-12, JK-12) will be considered based on current enrolment and projected enrolment, school utilization, facility condition and program (ex. French Immersion, Special Education, etc.), and other factors.



GEDSB Boundary Review Reference Criteria:

Where possible, boundary options should take into consideration:

School Utilization

- maximize the use of existing facilities and minimize the number of students in portables or temporary structures.
- maximize the number of facilities that adequately meet student and community needs for accessibility.
- Consider the equity of facilities, site, size and program standards.
- All facilities should provide safe and secure learning environments for all students and staff.



GEDSB Boundary Review Reference Criteria:

Where possible, boundary options should take into consideration:

Program offerings

- Maximize access to and equity of program offerings (i.e. French Immersion, Special Education, etc.)
- Minimize the number of combined grades at a school.



GEDSB Boundary Review Reference Criteria:

Where possible, boundary options should take into consideration:

Transportation

 Maximize the number of students within a school boundary who are within walking distance, minimizing the need for transportation and annual operating costs.

Transitions

Minimize the number of transitions for students where changes are proposed.


Boundary Review Special Ad Hoc Committee Background

Growth in East Brantford has increased enrolment at Woodman-Cainsville School.

- Woodman-Cainsville School capacity 178%, 9 portables.
 Further increases projected
- Enrolment increases also expected at Central and Major Ballachey Public Schools

Boundary Review Special Ad Hoc Committee Background

- 2022-2023 Capital Priorities Program
 - Business case submitted to Ministry of Education requesting approval for 6 classroom addition
- Request did not receive funding approval
- June 2022 GEDSB Board of Trustees approve Brantford East Boundary Review
