
# **Operation Christmas Child Shoebox**

This is an international program that sends thousands of shoeboxes filled with essential items such as toothbrushes, soap and school supplies as well as fun gifts such as small balls and dolls to impoverished children around the world. Courtland Public School is going to try and fill 50 Shoeboxes. Please email your teacher if you wish to receive a shoebox to fill. All shoeboxes need to be returned November 21st; so that they can be delivered to the organization.

# **Allergies at School:**

We have children in the school who have severe, life threatening food allergies (anaphylaxis) to nuts and eggs. This includes food which contains peanuts, peanut oil, or any other kind of nuts or traces of peanuts/nuts/shellfish in them. Products which contain nuts like Nutella are not permitted. Our egg allergy is currently confined to our kindergarten classrooms. Anaphylaxis is a medical condition which causes a severe reaction to specific foods and can result in death within minutes. This requires the attention of our entire school community to ensure students are safe. All our staff is aware of the situation and they have been instructed in the correct procedures regarding anaphylactic shock.
