#### **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS**

In order to register you must submit the following documents in electronic format (.pdf, .jpg, .png):

- Proof of Home Address to prove you are or will be living in the PDHS boundaries when school starts (Utility Statement, Purchase/Rental/Lease Agreement, Bank Document). A Driver's License cannot be used as proof of address.
- Child's Proof of Age and Legal Name (Birth Certificate, Certificate of Canadian Citizenship, Certificate of Registration of Birth Abroad, Passport, Permanent Resident Card, Record of Landing)
- Confirmation of Date of Entry into Canada, if applicable, and if the date is within the previous four school years. (Permanent Resident Card, Record of Landing, Confirmation of Permanent Residence).
- Custody paperwork if applicable
- Copy of recent **IEP** if applicable
- Students in Gr. 10-12, copy of most recent transcript & report card

### What is the next step after I submit my documents?

Once all documentation is received and reviewed, <u>if</u> an interview is required to complete your registration (applicable for Gr. 10-12 students), we will contact you to meet with the Vice Principal. Without the required documentation, your registration will not be completed.

The PDHS Registration/Timetable pick up day is usually held in late-August. The Main Office will notify families over the summer with details.

#### **Busing Information**

Student Transportation Services Brantford Haldimand Nortfolk (STSBHN) will post bus routes/times in mid August. Create a parent account on their website. Once your request is approved by STSBHN in mid-August, add the student to your account for route info. Students cannot be added before August or if the request has been declined. Use the student's Ontario Education Number (OEN) as the student number on the STSBHN site. The OEN can be found on the student's report card. All decisions are made solely by the busing company.
