THAT the Board approve the contract for the construction of the joint elementary school and childcare facility located in Caledonia to Tambro Construction Ltd. in the amount of **\$26,810,000**.

Background

The Grand Erie District School Board (Grand Erie), together with the Brant Haldimand Norfolk Catholic District School Board (BHNCDSB), has completed the design phase of a new school facility comprised of two (2) separate elementary schools (one school for each board) and a Childcare Centre (operated by Grand Erie) consolidated into on single building, located in Caledonia, Ontario.

In November 2021, the Ministry of Education provided both boards with funding to address the enrolment pressure in Caledonia by constructing a new 746 pupil place joint-use elementary school. The general scope of the project is to construct a joint-use elementary school which would include shared spaces such as the library and gymnasiums. The new build, which will include approximately 75,000 square feet of constructed space, will include the following construction scope for Grand Erie:

- 3 Kindergarten classrooms
- 15 regular classrooms
- 2 Specialized Services Spaces
- Shared use of a 7,400 square foot gymnasium
- Shared use of an 1,800 square foot library/learning commons.

The Brant Haldimand Norfolk Catholic District School Board issued a Request to Tender #T-0824 on March 14, 2024, with a closing date of April 23, 2024. The tender was issued to five (5) prequalified general contractors. (Reference: BHNCDSB RFSQ-823.)

Bids were received from three (3) of the general contracting companies from the prequalified list and the results are listed in the table below:

Additional Information

Purchasing Services for both school boards have completed the necessary evaluation steps of the competitive process and recommend the award of the construction contract to **Tambro Construction Ltd.** being the lowest Bidder for the Stipulated Bid Price. This aligns with the amount estimated for this project as documented the most recent Class A Cost Estimate provided to both school boards and summarized in the January 2024 Approval to Proceed to tender report.
