# School Communications and School Messenger:

Communication between the school and home is an essential part of school life. Grand Erie completed the selection process for a parent communication/notification system that delivers large volumes of messages through multiple channels. The provider selected is School Messenger and they are compatible with PowerSchool. Parents can easily set preferences for how they want to be reached and the messages can be delivered by phone, email, text etc. Such examples includes board-/school-wide special announcements, closures due to inclement weather, power outages, safe School situations (Shelter in Place, Hold & Secure, and Lockdown), pizza days, events and other announcements. The service will be provided in all schools in Grand Erie District School Board in 2015-16 with a pilot group in August (Simcoe Composite School and North Park). The plan will be in place to deliver the service to the entire system – elementary and secondary.

A. Felsky inquired about the speech to text capability and available language preferences. M. Windle confirmed there is the capability for text to speech in 20 different languages.

### (c) General Contractor Award – Change Room Renovation at Pauline Johnson CVS (PJ)

J. Gunn explained the plan to convert classrooms at the back of PJ to change rooms and washrooms.

He referred to the floor plans and pointed out that the change rooms/washrooms could be completely closed off from the school as needed so that it could be accessible to the community while booking the field.

The benefits to the school is the use of these change rooms/washrooms during the regular school hours while using the field for physical education programs. A wheelchair accessible washroom is also included in the project plans.

He acknowledged that this tendered price is over budget which would be covered by facility renewal funding. Pending board approval of this contract, work is scheduled to begin July 2, 2015 to be available to students for the fall of 2015. He explained that the field plans provide for a concession stand in the field house between the bleachers.
